ment from faculty, the graduating student should then be in a position to make an informed decision regarding which program or which college to select to apply for future studies.

The functions of this program are

1. To upgrade the portfolios and enhance the visual and perceptive skills of artistically-inclined students.
2. To expose students to the numerous visual career options available to them and to counsel them regarding such career choices.
