## **Key to: Writing Successfully Speaking Persuasively Reading Effectively**

**T**he Communications courses you take will:

- Improve your basic writing skills.
- Strengthen your research techniques.
- Develop your professional business writing skills, helping you increase your ability to express your ideas.

**There are three important courses to help you:**

- ***Language Skills***  
This course builds confidence in your ability to express yourself while you learn the fundamentals of writing.
- ***Communications I***  
This course develops your editing and vocabulary skills while increasing your ability to write research papers.
- ***Communications II***  
This course refines your writing while you develop the business writing techniques you'll need for your future career.

## **H**ow to Enroll:

When you arrive at Humber, you'll write an evaluation test. From the results of this test, you'll be assigned to the courses which meet your needs.

To graduate, you must have credits or advanced standing in these courses.
