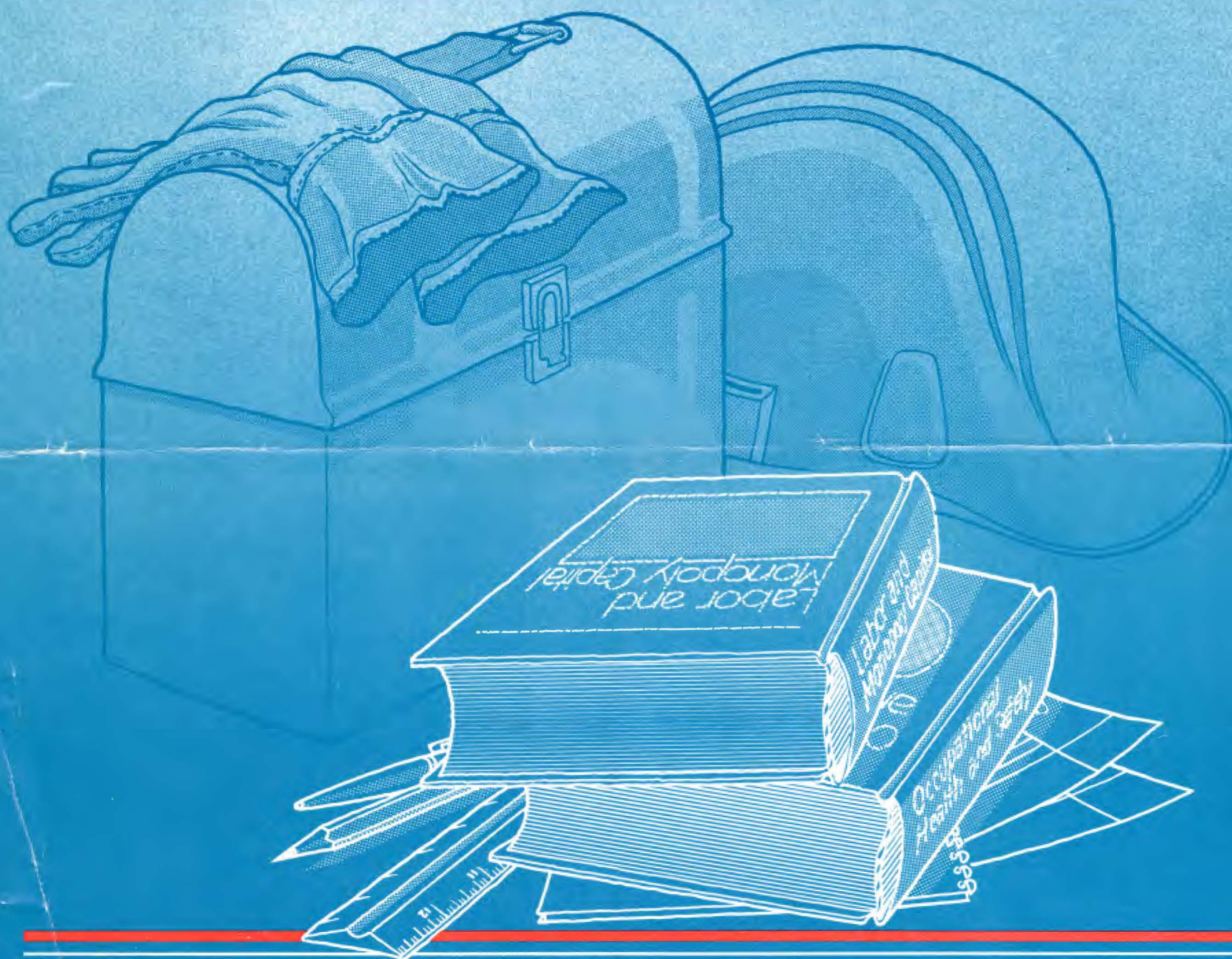

As a joint project between the Labour Council of Metro Toronto and Humber College, the Centre offers a variety of relevant courses on issues that affect you and the work environment such as health and safety, technological change, collective bargaining, labour law, english in the workplace, and Bill 70 programs for immigrant workers.

Each course is taught by a trade unionist and is worth three credits toward the Certificate in Labour Studies. Courses usually consist of ten three hour sessions; are offered in the evenings, on weekends and during the day; and are held at various local union halls.
