Rowntree described the colleges of applied arts and technology scheme as "a great experience for the province.

He said it is now necessary to extend the educational system to meet the demands of a new world. "The need today can't be met by adding to altering our secondary school system," said Rowntree. "It can only be met by institutions like Humber College.

> "Appropriate post-secondary education is a necessity for all secondary school graduates, not just those planning to go on to university." "If you want economic advancement, the place to make your investment is in education," he said.

MINORITY GROUP

Wragg stated that only four of every 100 students starting grade nine will complete his first degree in university.
"Yet, it is this minority group of four out of every 100 which has in the past been glamorized and publicized. Education must not be the monopoly of an academic minority.
